Gerhard Gerritzen (born in 1955) was appointed Deputy Managing Director of Messe München on January 1, 2010. He is responsible for the capital-goods fairs transport logistic, transport logistic China, logitrans, ceramitec and Indian Ceramics. Within the company he is in charge of the Central Division Financial and Legal Affairs, the Central Division Construction and Engineering and the Central Division IT.

Before becoming a member of the Management Board, Mr. Gerritzen held a number of executive positions at Messe München GmbH. Among other things, he has been responsible for administration, trade-fair services, data processing, purchasing and legal affairs. In 1998 he was appointed Head of the Central Division Internal Services, which included the departments of Finance, Controlling, Legal Affairs, Central Purchasing and Organization. In that position, Mr. Gerritzen was also responsible for properties, affiliate companies and insurances. In 1999 he was granted a general commercial power of attorney for the company (*Prokura*).
